

To the Jews I became as a Jew,
in order to win Jews.

- Paul would go to the synagogues so Jews could hear the gospel. **Acts 17:2 (9:20; 13:4, 13, etc.)**
- Though a Jew who left Judaism as a means of salvation he knew the mind of fellow Jews and tried to reach them where they were at.




To those under the law I became as one under the law

- Among the Jews whose consciences were so tied to the law Paul would be sensitive to them.
- Thus, he had Timothy (whose mother was Jewish and thus he would be considered such) abide by the law and be circumcised. [Acts 16:3](#)
- Paul would practice the law himself. [Acts 18:18](#)

To those outside the law I became as one outside the law

- He met the Gentiles where they were as well.
- When in Athens he preached to them in a manner they could relate. [Acts 17:21-23](#)



To the weak I became weak,
that I might win the weak.

- What was true to help the unbeliever come to Christ would also be true for those who are “weak” in Christ.
- Paul made it obviously clear to the “weak” (defiled conscience) among the saints.

1 Cor. 8 (see v. 13)

*For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.... I have become all things to all people, **that by all means I might save some.** I do it all for the sake of the gospel, **that I may share with them in its blessings.** (1 Co 9:19–23).*
