- Or: to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ

- that we should no longer be children
 - tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine:
 - by the trickery of men
 - in the cunning craftiness of deceitful plotting,

How TO Reach The Goal: Ephesians 4:15

- "but, Speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head— Christ—"
- "from whom the whole body... by what every joint supplies... causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love."

Purpose: for the edifying of the body of Christ.

Building the body in love... Romans 12:9-21

- Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is good.
- Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love,
- in honor giving preference to one another;
- not lagging in diligence,
- fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
- rejoicing in hope,
- patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer;
- distributing to the needs of the saints,
- given to hospitality.

Building the body in love... Romans 12:9-21

- Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.
- Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.
- Be of the same mind toward one another.
- Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble.
- Do not be wise in your own opinion.
- Repay no one evil for evil.
- Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.

Building the body in love... Romans 12:9-21

- If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.
- Beloved, do not avenge yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, feed him; If he is thirsty, give him a drink; For in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head."
- Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good."
